General Program Requirements

In order to qualify, you must be a resident of the state of California and a parent or primary caregiver responsible for a child(ren) who attends school (high school or under).

In order to qualify, you also must have an annual household income (before taxes) that is below the following amounts:

8	\$73,316

***For households with more than eight people, add \$7,437 per additional person.**
